- On-line sources: Ancestry.com, familysearch.org, findagrave.com, state & county web sites) the records they contain and how best to find what you need
- Citations (how to document information sources) and organization of your records

At the end of the course the student will be able to:

- Document their immediate ancestors and generate a family tree
- Know how to use various on-line resources
- Understand different source types (authored works, original records (primary & secondary) and derivative records

The focus of this course is U. S. records
