Finding Your Immigrant Ancestor's Home Town

Knowing your immigrant ancestor's place of birth, or last known residence before emigrating, is essential to finding his records in the "old country". How do you find these locations when every record you have found lists only the country of origin?

We will cover what records are available to help you locate your ancestor's home town. Traditional records, lesser known records, other sources and what to do when you still have not found that elusive home town will be discussed.

Ann has been working on her genealogy for 32 years. After moving to Florida, from Connecticut, in 1992 she took a genealogy class at the Largo Library offered by the Pinellas Genealogy Society. She then attended the Suncoast Genealogy Society Seminar and joined both PGS and SGS in 1993. She is a Past President of SGS and has held every office over the years except Treasurer.

Ann is currently the SGS Historian and co-chair of the Education Committee. She has been one of the SGS Beginning Genealogy Class instructors since 2013.
